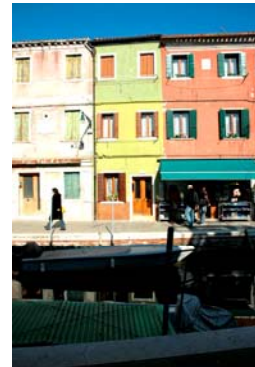

My name is Robert (Bob) Davis and I lead photography workshops and photo safaris in North Central Oregon and South Eastern Washington. I'm writing to you to extend an invitation to you and your camera club members to attend our events. Please visit my web site at www.ghosttownsafaris.com for information about myself, there's a brief Bio there, as well as upcoming events.

We encourage all types of photography including large format and digital. Having gone digital myself I have become more prone to the digital way of photography as apposed to film and have found it to be an excellent art medium to work within.

During our events we travel extensively throughout Eastern Oregon and South Eastern Washington photographing not only ghost towns, but, homesteads, one-hundred-year-old churches, barns, scenics, Oregon Trail grave yards, and much more. Most people do an average of 400 to 500 images a day with one individual topping the mark with over 1,430 images. The majority of our attendees have won multiple awards and ribbons for the images they created while traveling with us. Not only do we travel in Washington and Oregon, but, also in Montana and Idaho photographing the mining ghost towns there.
