Tom Lentz will give a presentation on "Dual Flash Macrophotography" He will demonstrate on a digital camera and will show slides of images taken.

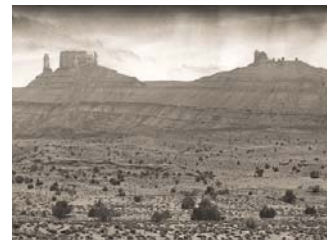
Tom will also judge for us.
