WORKSHOPS, CLASSES AND ITEMS OF INTEREST:

WORLD WIDE PINHOLE DAY MAKE YOUR OWN CAMERA

World Wide Pinhole Day will be held on April 29, 2007. Last year over 2250 photographers from 60 countries uploaded images (1 per photographer) that they had made on that day to the WWPD website. Wppd-list@pinholeday.org to view last years images and to enter your image this year Image must be taken on April 29, 2007

Here in Denver, Working with Artists has a pinhole day event. Last year that included being able to use the darkroom at Silver Print for developing and printing images at no charge.

This year Jim Stewart will do a workshop on March 31 starting at 9 am at his house (16759 East Ada Pl.) for those who are interested in making their own pinhole camera. In the morning we will make pinholes and put them in body caps (bring your own) for use on film or digital cameras and make traditional pinhole cameras from tin boxes. In the afternoon we can convert either Holga 120N or Polaroid Colorpack 2 camera to pinhole. Again, if you want to do this, bring your own camera to convert. Rocky Mountain Arsenal National Wildlife Refuge

Some photo opportunities: Take advantage of the Refuge's *new* early morning hours. On each Sat and Sun you are able to enter at 6am, No reservation required. Good time to photograph the birds and other wildlife.

Visitors will now be able to come and enjoy the Refuge more often and stay longer! The Drop-in Program is expanded to include Tuesdays and Wednesdays in addition to Saturdays and Sundays. For birders, **photographers**, and early morning nature enthusiasts, the Refuge opens at 6:00 am and closes at 6:00 pm with Visitor Center hours from 7:30 am to 4:00 pm.

Wild Rides, the Refuge's two-hour wildlife public viewing tour, is offered on Wednesdays and Saturdays at 10:00 am by reservation. There are two different tour routes available at scheduled times for visitors to view and photograph wildlife, from burrowing owls to bison.
