WORKSHOPS, CLASSES AND ITEMS OF INTEREST:

Proposed changes in the Standing Rules for CCCC Competition

1. **A more logical, consistent system of awards is proposed for both quarterly and year-end competitions.** (this increases the amount of HM to be given)
2. **It is proposed that all references to “Altered” and “Unaltered” be removed from the Standing Rules for both quarterly and year-end competitions.**(this means that there will no longer be any separation between “altered and unaltered “images
3. **It is proposed that a new competition category, “Projected Digital Images” (PDI), be added with separate categories of “Monochrome” and “Color” for both quarterly and year-end competitions. To implement this, the following parts are proposed:**
 - a. **The category called “Slides” will be called “Projected Images” and include both slides and PDI.**
 - b. **Projected Images will be restricted to no more than twelve in a quarterly competition, split as the club wishes among slides, monochrome PDI and color PDI.**
4. **PDI competitions will be added to the 2007 Year-End Competition to be held in Spring, 2008.**(this would be for this year only as #3 above will be in effect for 2008)

Some changes in wording and order are proposed for consistency and clarity
