WORKSHOPS, CLASSES AND ITEMS OF INTEREST:

The Colorado Council of Camera Clubs is proposing some "Standing Rules" changes.

One is to eliminate the quarterly competitions for the year 2009. We as a club discussed this several months ago and at that time voted to keep the quarterly competition. (Now we have the official proposal.) If the proposal passes, there would no quarterly competitions only the year end competition. If it fails to pass, the quarterly competitions and year end will remain the same.

Second proposal is to eliminate Stereo Images from Year End competition. (There have been no entries in this category for the past couple of years)

For those of you who are new. The Council consists of five photo clubs in the Denver metro area and the quarterly competition is an interclub competition in which each club can enter 12 print images and 12 projected images.

The year - end is also a interclub competition allowing more images to be entered, cash awards or awards for the winners. It is usually a half day long activity with a potluck lunch, showing of the images and awards given.
